## WHAT IS LCLD?

Established in 2009, the Leadership Council on Legal Diversity (LCLD) is an organization of over 400 Members-Managing Partners and General Counsel from leading law firms and corporate legal departments-committed to creating an environment where all talent can thrive.

## WHY THE MENTORING PROGRAM?

To help accomplish our mission, LCLD offers talent development programs beginning in law school. The LCLD Success in Law School Mentoring Program provides first-year law students from diverse backgrounds with practical advice and guidance to maximize their potential in law school and beyond.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

1Ls who participate as mentees are matched 1:1 with practicing attorneys from LCLD Member organizations. Mentees receive individual, personalized mentoring to help them navigate law school and their future legal career.

Flexible Program Model: students may choose to participate virtually or in their city. In the virtual model, students are matched with mentors anywhere in the country and the mentoring occurs virtually. In the city model, students are matched with local mentors so that mentoring can occur in-person when possible.

**1L Launchpad Webinars**: this virtual series provides an opportunity for mentees to learn from expert speakers on topics like time management, resiliency, and career planning.
