Admission Requirements

Master of Law Program Online (LL.M. Online)

Specific Requirements for the Online Master of Law (LL.M. Online)

- Juris Doctor degree with a 3.00 GPA from an institution accredited by the American Bar Association (ABA), a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in law from a foreign higher education institution or university education institution, which is based on high academic standards and fully recognized by the country's state authorities in which it is located.
- Proficiency in the Spanish language and ability to read and understand in English. Proficiency in Spanish or English may be demonstrated if the student has studied in either of these languages at a duly accredited university. Special attention will be paid to reading and understanding skills in English and Spanish.
- It is highly recommended that the applicant have at least two or three years of previous work experience in the legal field.
- Have a computer with high-speed internet access or a mobile device with data service and sufficient capacity to reproduce multimedia material, and have the necessary skills to use it as a work tool. It should also have built-in or external speakers and a webcam or cell phone with a camera and microphone.

Required documents for the Admission's Application

- Application for Admission to Graduate Studies in electronic format.
- Evidence of having obtained a Juris Doctor Degree or equivalent degree in Law, as described above.
- Two official transcripts of all university approved or validated by the institution of origin.
- Two letters of recommendation, at least one of them must be academic, describing in detail the academic aptitudes, professional experience and character of the applicant.
- Curriculum vitae
- Personal Statement that includes background and personal profile, motivations for studying a master's degree in Law, areas of interest and career plans.
- Two official transcripts of all university credits approved or validated by the institution of origin, authenticated and apostilled, sent directly to the Law School's mailing address. The transcripts must be sent to:
